Over the decades, the OSCE has evolved into a cornerstone of nursing assessment across countries like the United Kingdom (NMC OSCE), Australia (AHPRA OSCE), New Zealand, and Ireland (RCSI Aptitude Test). It bridges the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-world practice, ensuring that nurses meet the highest standards of safe and effective patient care.
